

Policy on Examination Arrangements

Examinations are a stressful time and it is important that everyone is aware of how the school will operate during examination times in order to ensure that things run as smoothly as possible.

- The Code of Behaviour and College Rules apply during examinations.
- Students are to wear their school uniform for Wednesday, Thursday and Friday of the first week of the exams. From Monday of the second week casual clothes are allowed. Rules on piercings still apply.
- Parents may collect students between examinations. If this is to happen
 - A note to this effect is provided to the Principal.
 - Pupils must be collected from the front of the school.
 - Friends calling with cars is not acceptable.

Other than above, students are not given permission to leave the school between examinations. During examination time the Principal/ Deputy Principal/ Examination Aide will provide assistance to students as required.

- Students must stay away from the Play School area.
- A study area will be provided for students between examinations.
- Lunch orders are not taken during exams.

Students leaving examinations early will be required to be collected by parents.

Pupils who usually travel on private buses must make their own arrangement.

School transport scheme buses are available during examinations.

Buses arrive before the first examination and leave after the end of the last examination of the day. Parents and students should be aware of the end time of their own examinations and make their own arrangements for collection, if possible.
